Prof. Eddah Gachukia. MBS is known for her passion for girl's education and women's empowerment. She founded together with African women education ministers Forum for African Women Educationists (FAWE) in 1992. FAWE's membership is composed of education minister and women vice chancellors because it is focused on influencing national policies on education of girls and women in the continent. She was also a vice-chair of Maendeleo ya Wanawake.In 1974, Eddah was nominated as a Member of Parliament, joining Grace Onyango and Jemima Gichaga who were the only women in parliament then. Eddah would again be nominated to parliament between 1979 and 1984. In parliament, she advocated for women interests, family planning and child spacing. She was a member of the women's negotiating team throughout the review process. She was among the women who formed the political wing of the Affirmative Action.
