# **HOW ARE WE GROWING?**



Perhaps the highest leap of all-round growth is being observed in the RECEPTION CLASS. They will be focusing on continuing to build an increased vocabulary and independence skills among other things.

There is a lot of new learning planned in the **PP1 CLASS** in Language Activities. The children are learning how to blend letter sounds to read words and have also been introduced to the Reading Programme.

The PP1 class parents will see and hear all this and more during the CURRICULUM ORIENTATION MEETING scheduled for Wednesday 19th June 2024. Kindly plan to attend; the children and their teachers have a lot planned just for you.



The **PP2** CLASS is also growing and expanding their repertoire of spoken and written vocabulary among other skills through various activities. This being their last year in Kindergarten, the children together with their teachers are working hard to ensure a seamless transition to Grade 1.


